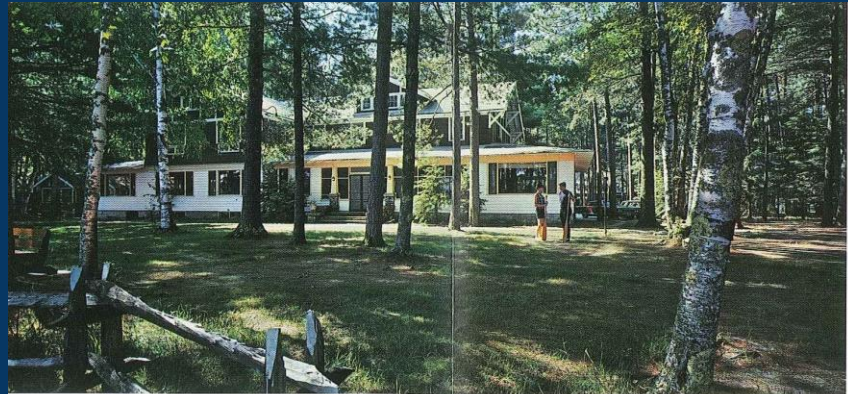

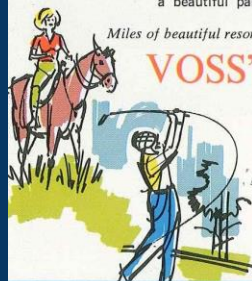

MANITOWISH WATERS AREA

THE MANITOWISH WATERS SKIING SKEETERS

Manitowish Waters, "Barefoot Water Skiing Capital of the Midwest," offers organized weekly water ski shows and activities on its lakes.

The Skiing Skeeters have as their predecessors the young members of the Manitowish Waters Boat Club, a group established to foster water safety and interest in water sports.

The present group is a 1961 revival that took the name, Manitowish Waters Skiing Skeeters. Summer residents and all-year inhabitants form a membership of over 50 individuals. Members are selected on the basis of interest and cooperation as well as skiing talent, and they move up the ladder from a junior to senior or full membership status.

The Skiing Skeeters take pride in their new 19 foot Mastercraft competition water ski boat with a 351 cubic inch powerslot engine used for top of the line performance and competition skiing. The club also owns a 16 foot checkmate pickup boat powered by a 115 h.p. Johnson outboard motor, extensive skiing, lighting and public address equipment, and maintains all its equipment at its own expense. Its only financial support comes from members' dues and voluntary contributions from the public. The Skeeters new location is two miles off of Hwy. 51 on County trunk W on Rest Lake.

Two evenings a week - during July and August at 7 p.m. - Wednesdays and Sundays - the Skeeters and lovely Sketeorettes present free ski shows, each an eighty minute array of acts highlighted by jumping, barefoot skiing, a pyramid and ever popular clown routines at their new Rest Lake Ski Bowl.

Annually in August they stage their barefoot competition, the Beier Barefoot Tournament, open only to club members. The Skeeters' interest in barefoot skiing has given the three of five top barefooters in the state, the state champion barefoot team four years in succession and a reputation for keen competition in the most difficult of all forms of skiing. The nationwide publicity accorded to the club have established its claim that Manitowish Waters is the "Barefoot Capital of the Midwest."

Manitowish Waters Sno-Skeeters

The Manitowish Waters Sno-Skeeters Snowmobile Club was first started in 1968 by a group of local people interested in snowmobile safety and progress in Northern Wisconsin. Since they started memberships have tripled with more and more people gaining interest in this active sport.

The Club now maintains about 30 miles of trails from which you may travel to Boulder Junction, Woodruff, Winchester, Presque Isle, Springstead, Mercer and Manitowish Waters. The trail groomer works as often as Mother Nature lets it work.

There is also a Junior Club which helps run activities for the younger set. Ron Brice is the president of this organization for anyone who is interested in memberships.

The present officers of our club are President — Bruce Nett; Secretary — Mary Dreesang and Treasurer — Jane Bals. For any information of membership — just write to the Sno-Skeeters, and we'll send you forms.

Some of the yearly activities put on by the club are the Annual Ice - In party in December, also the Santa Claus Parade, the Scavenger Hunt, the Annual Fox Island Picnic and the Yearly Banquet. All of these activities are held on weekends so everyone can attend.

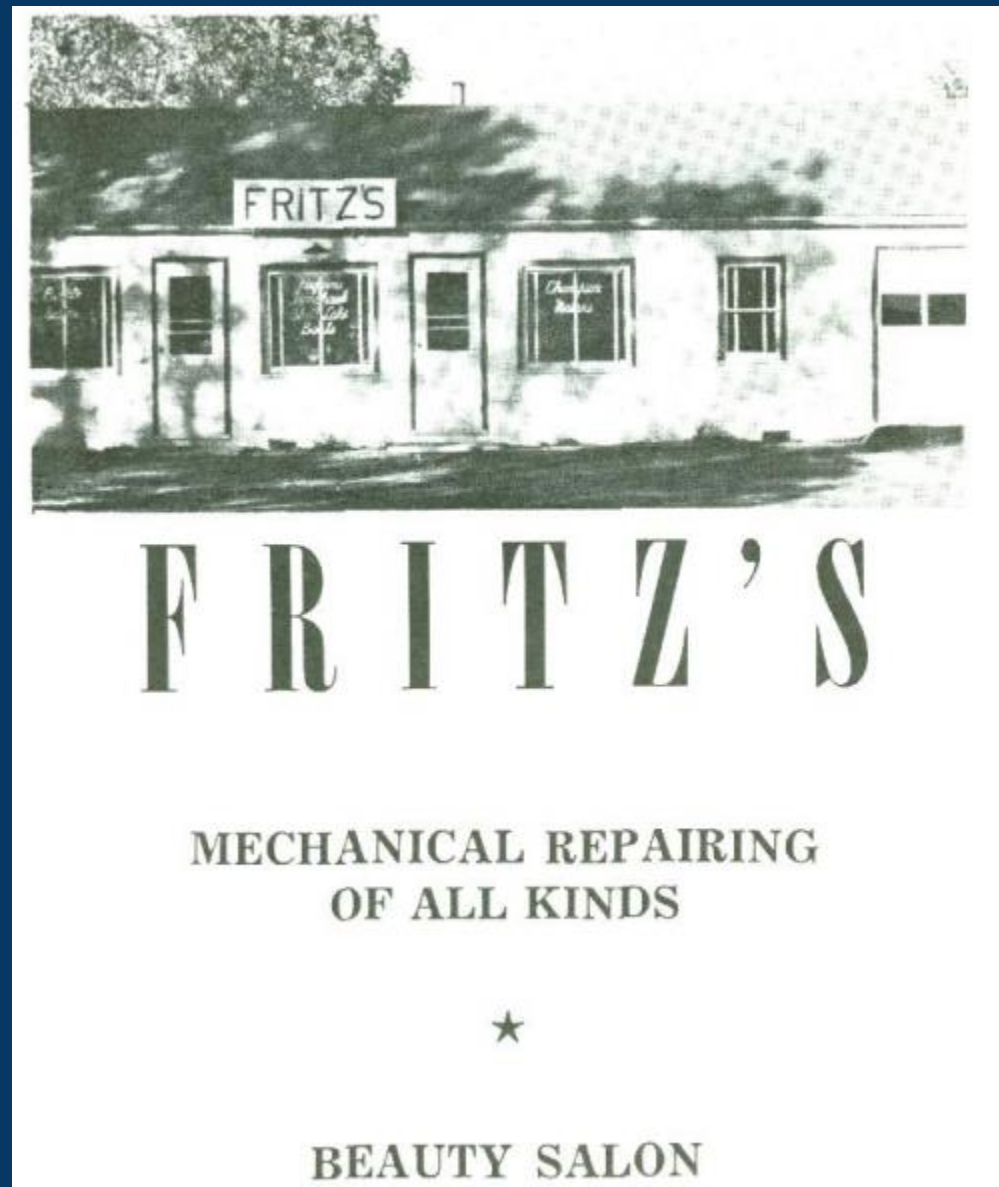

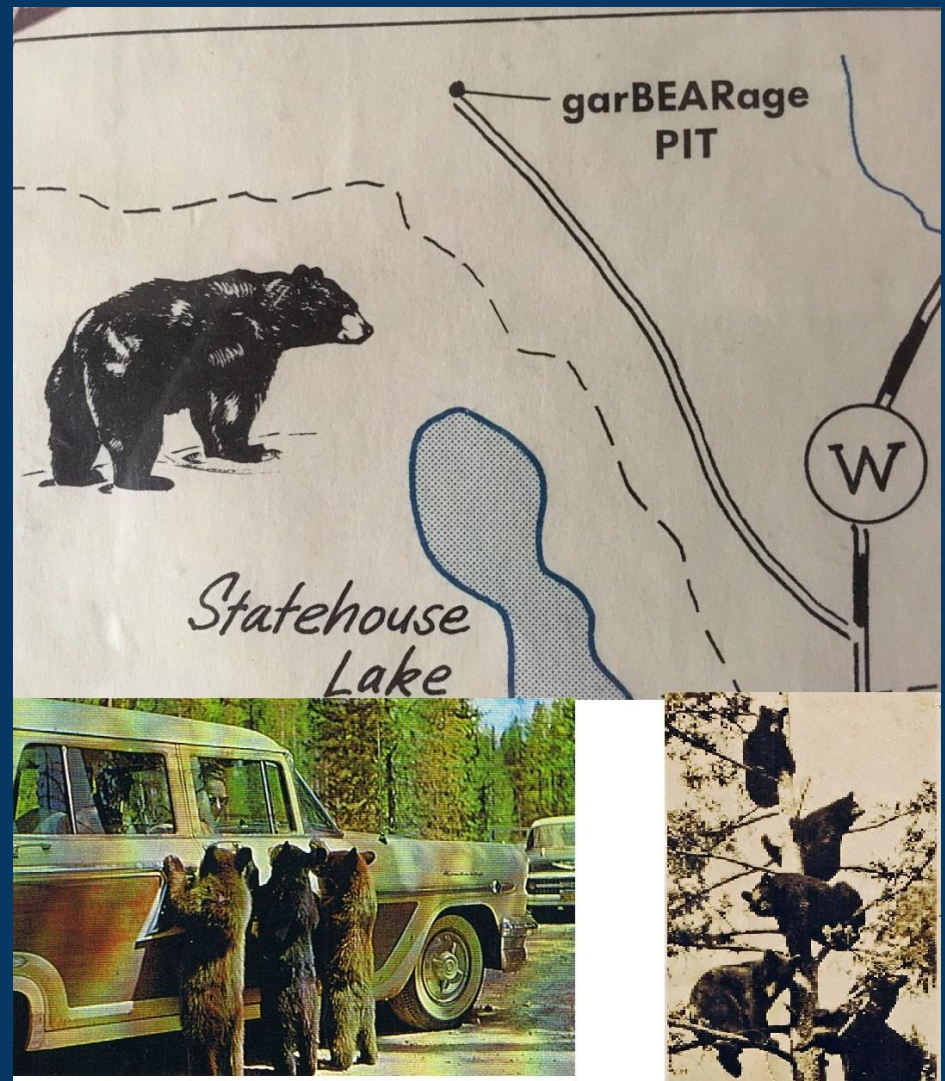

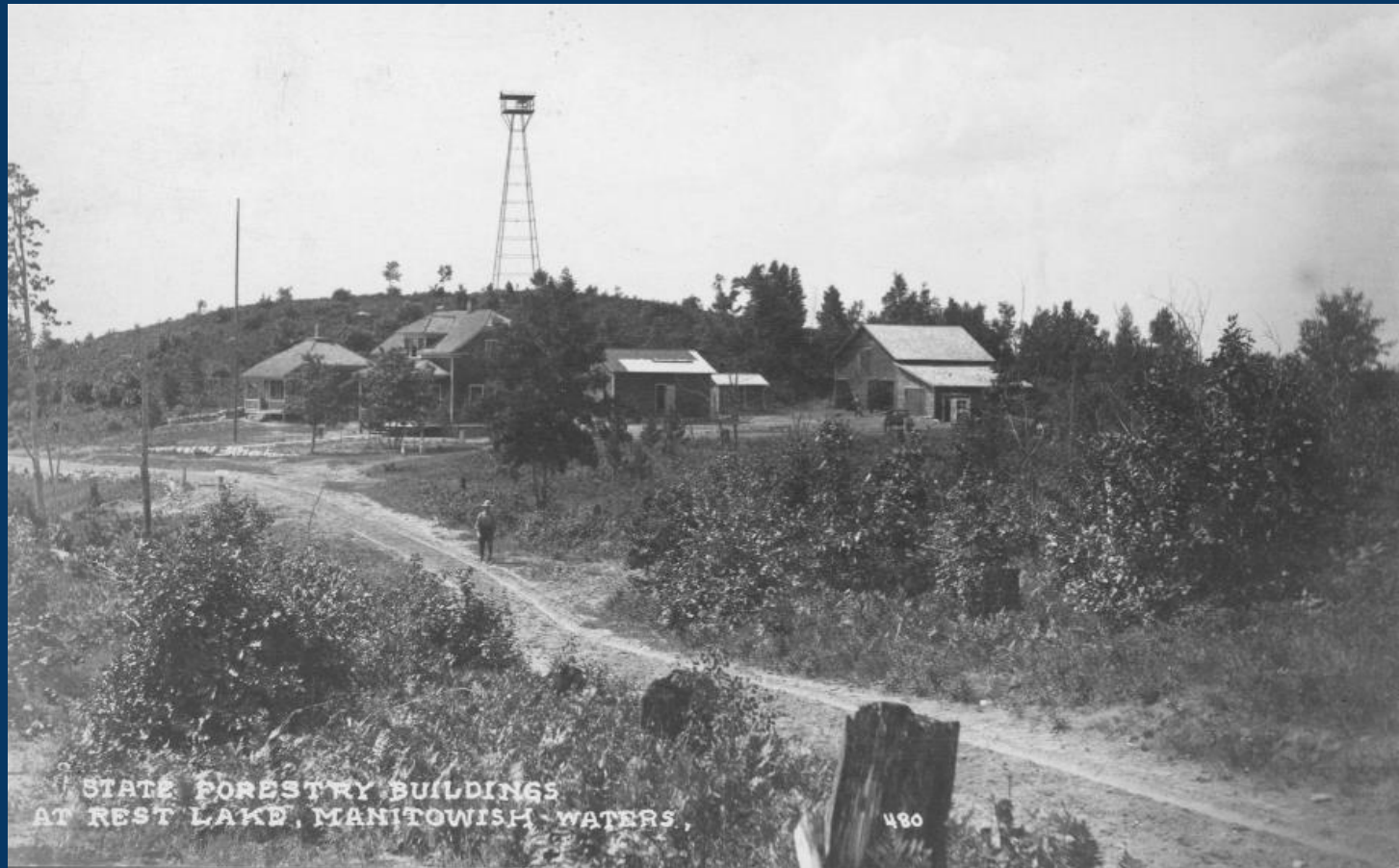
